



Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you heve enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product. this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in lhe same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people .



 Toreouce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste.

Handy Hints


- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts


In order to help prevent overturning - please follow these instructions

To prolong wear & tear and avoid damaging the product, please follow the suggestions below:


- Avoid putting excessive weights inside the drawers.

- Painted doors should not be cleaned with soluble cleaners; all benzene and resin solvents are not suitable for use as panel cleaning agents.




